Winter in Norway is something truly special. The mighty Sognefjord is an epic sight to behold anytime, but is by many considered to be at it's most spectacular during the winter season. The deep fjord is flanked by snowy mountains, frozen waterfalls and white landscapes. It's less busy, more peaceful and truly a tranquil experience.

Winter tour highlights

- The scenic Bergen Railway and the breath-taking Flâm Railway through exotic winter landscapes
- A pitoresque bus ride along the fjord from Flâm to the idyllic village of Balestrand
- An extensive cruise on the Sognefjord to see amazing snow-capped mountain scenery and frozen waterfalls
- The beautiful coastal archipelago outside of Bergen
